City of Los Angeles Soft-Story Retrofit Program

The City of Los Angeles has enacted Ordinance # 183893 (Mandatory Earthquake Hazard Reduction in Existing Wood Frame Buildings with Soft, Weak or Open Front Walls), otherwise known as the Soft-Story Retrofit program. Under this Ordinance, The City of Los Angeles, Department of Building and Safety (“LADBS”) will make a determination if your building meets the following criteria:

1. Wood Frame Construction with two or more stories;
2. Built under building code standards enacted before January 1, 1978;
3. Ground floor parking or other similar open floor space that causes, soft weak or open wall lines.

The property owner will then be required to hire an engineer or architect licensed in the state of California to evaluate the strength of the building. The engineer or architect must then develop plans for the building’s seismic strengthening in compliance with the program.

This program is mandated by the City of Los Angeles so as to reduce the risk of injury or loss of life that may result from the effects of earthquakes on wood frame soft-story buildings. Importantly, this program does not apply to residential buildings with three or less units.

The City of Los Angeles defines a Soft-Story Building, as a structure that has a weaker first floor and is unable to carry the weight of the stories above during an earthquake. The first floor generally has large openings in the perimeter walls such as garages, tuck-under parking or even large windows. LADBS will be sending out an Order to Comply, to all property owners whose properties meet the criteria detailed above.
